- The Resource Conservation & Development (RC&D) Program was first authorized by the Food and Agriculture Act of 1962, has been permanently authorized by the 2002 Farm Bill, and is administered by the United States Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service.
- The USDA's intent is to develop a cost-effective program that builds local working relationships for conserving and developing natural resources and enhances the social, economic, and environmental conditions in the United States.

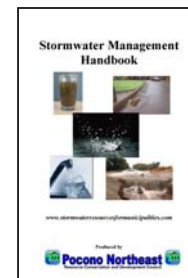
